### Science

- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a nonfiction book about science.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a science fiction novel.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Do any activity relating to science. (You can research and perform a full science experiment, do an everyday activity like planting a garden, or anything in between.)

### Technology

- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a (fiction or nonfiction) book about technology.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a book that is not in a traditional print format. (This can be an audiobook, a book on your computer or eReader, etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Use a piece of technology that you have never used before.

### Engineering

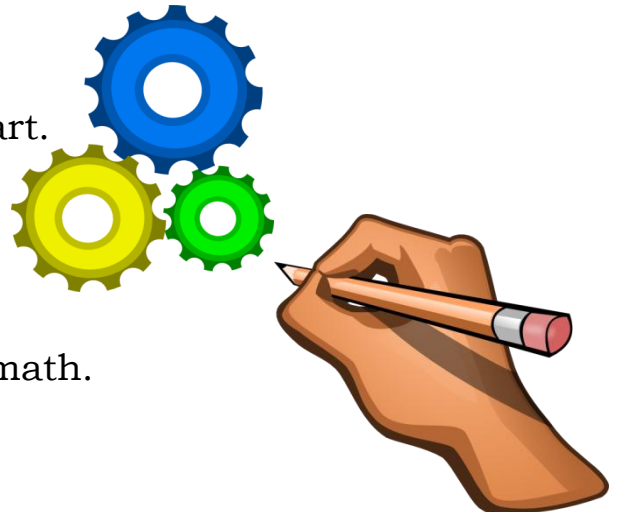
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read a (fiction or nonfiction) book about engineering, architecture, or physics.
