At our wrap-up party, we will hand out small gifts to any program participant who reads **at least one book**, adds it to his reading log, and returns that log to the library by August 24 at 5 p.m. (There is a paper log attached, but if you register and log books online, we receive that information automatically.)

Read a fictional book about music.	Sing a song.	Attend a library program.	Watch a movie with Dwayne “The Rock” Johnson.	Read a book that features rocks (or gems or a mountain, etc.).
Do a craft or science project relating to rocks.	Watch a movie, TV show, or documentary featuring music.	Read a book with a title that begins with the letter M, U, S, I, or C.	Listen to a musical artist that you never have before.	Identify a rock in the wild. (At least figure out which of the 3 major rock groups it belongs to.)
Use a library database.	Read a book with a title that begins with the letter R, O, C, or K.	 Free!	Read a book with a title taken from song lyrics.*	Listen to a musical genre that you usually don't.
Identify at least one band or artist on the mural in the Children's Department of the library.	Learn something about music that you didn't know before (history, theory, etc.).	Read a book in which the author or a character shares a name with a musical artist.^	Dance (or get up and move around to a song).	Read a nonfiction book about music.
Attend a library program.	Read a book with a music-themed word in the title.	Learn something about geology that you didn't know before.	Play a musical instrument. (Improvised instruments are allowed.)	Use a library database.

This contest is open to anyone who reads at least one book in our Adult Summer Reading Program. If you wish to participate, you may return this card to the library with your name and phone number by Friday, August 24 at 6:00 p.m. to be eligible for the prize. (Note: Each book or event may only be used for one Bingo square a piece.)

* Hint: A lot of books take their titles from children's nursery rhyme songs and Christmas songs.
^ For example, you could read a book by Jonathan Swift, who shares a surname with Taylor Swift, or a book featuring Perry Mason because of singer Katy Perry.
